### Tips on having a new kitten:

1. It's always good to have your kitten spayed or neutered by 6 months old.
2. Provide fresh food and water daily.
3. Make sure the kitten has clean litter at all times, and have the litter box in an easy accessible area. Have 1 litter box per cat/kitten.
4. If you are going to put a collar on your kitten make sure it is a break-away collar.
5. Keep household and automotive chemicals in a cabinet away from kitten.
6. Keep them away from electrical cords, blind and curtain cords.
7. Keep toilet lids down, kitten could drown.
8. Keep ribbon, string, yarn and any small items they can swallow away from them.
9. Some household plants are toxic to kittens, mistletoe, poinsettia and philodendron are a few to name. Try planting some Timothy grass or catnip in a stable pot for your kitten.
10. Make sure all medication, vitamins and pill bottles are put away in a cabinet.
